Given the growing community concerns and ongoing developments resulting from the coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic, and after consulting with the Health Centre, RCMP, Government of Nunavut Departments and other key stakeholders, Cambridge Bay Hamlet Council and Administration have decided to close all recreation facilities in the community. These closures are effective today, Monday March 16, 2020 through to April 7, 2020. The Hamlet will continue to monitor the situation and will provide updates and additional information as it becomes available.

The decision to close the Hamlet recreation facilities has not been taken lightly and is being made in the best interest of community residents and public health. We continue to encourage our community residents to take all reasonable precautions.
